

## Dundas/Mackenzie grave

### George Ralph Dundas

1845. Birth of George Ralph Dundas in Edinburgh, third son of George Dundas (Lord Manor) a Scottish lawyer and his wife Elizabeth Mackenzie.

1863. Undergraduate at Exeter College, Oxford but possibly didn't graduate.

1869. Died in Havant "on or about 20<sup>th</sup> March". March 20<sup>th</sup> is inscribed on the grave. Buried 25<sup>th</sup> March in New Lane cemetery.

### Anne Mackenzie

1813. Birth of Anne Mackenzie in Eddlestone near Peebles, Scotland, 13th August. Baptised 16<sup>th</sup> September. Parents Colin Mackenzie and Elisabeth Forbes.

1871. Recorded in Langstone as a visitor at the home of Ann Hinchliff. Also living there was Georgina Pigott. Both Ann and Georgina can be found in our document [The Granville Family](#).

1877. Death of Anne Mackenzie in Havant, 12<sup>th</sup> February. "Late of Woodfield, Havant". Woodfield has appeared in our research before and it still exists, though now converted in to flats.

PS. Anne was the younger sister of George's mother Elizabeth, born 1811. Given that Anne died in Ann Hinchliff's house, she may have been more than "a visitor"
